Alongside your on-the-job training, you'll attend college one day a week to gain industry-recognised qualifications, building the foundation for a rewarding and future-proof career in engineering.

Key Areas of Responsibility:

By the end of this exciting 48-month apprenticeship, you'll be a fully qualified Building Services Engineer, equipped with the knowledge and hands-on skills to confidently carry out Planned Preventative Maintenance (PPM) tasks to a professional standard. As part of the role, you will;

- Work 40 hours per week, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, with most of your time spent working on-site in Central London.
- Get exposure to plumbing, basic electrical and mechanical services, and gain practical experience maintaining specific building assets.
- Learn how to carry out maintenance tasks in line with SFG20 compliance standards, developing strong industry awareness.
- Attend college online or in person to undertake the building services engineering service and maintenance qualification (Level 3).
