Job Purpose:

The Project Manager for Gratte Brothers | Security Systems & Software is responsible for the end-to-end management and successful delivery of single or multiple security systems projects valued between £100k and £3m. Projects will range from £100k to £3m and systems will include but not be limited to CCTV, Access Control, IDS, PA, Intercom, Radio, IP Networks, BMS, traffic management including barriers and road blockers. The role ensures projects are delivered safely, on programme, to the highest quality standards, and at or above target profit margins, while maintaining full compliance with company, client, NSI and legislative requirements. Acting as the primary point of contact for clients, the Project Manager leads and coordinates design, installation, commercial performance, health & safety, quality, commissioning and handover activities, while also supporting, supervising and developing less experienced engineers to strengthen team capability and performance.

Key Areas of Responsibility:

- Manage the end-to-end delivery of single or multiple security systems projects, ensuring completion to agreed programme, quality standards and profit margins.
- Act as the primary point of contact for clients within the team's portfolio, maintaining effective communication and strong working relationships.
- Ensure full compliance with company procedures, NSI standards, client-specific requirements and all relevant legislative obligations across all projects.
- Manage and monitor project financial performance, including cost control, forecasting and the production of regular financial reports to senior management.
- Identify, propose and implement value engineering opportunities in consultation with senior management.
- Lead and manage Health & Safety delivery on all projects in line with company procedures, client processes and statutory requirements.
- Oversee project teams to ensure high standards of design coordination, installation quality, commissioning and handover.
- Ensure all required project documentation, drawings and records are produced, controlled, approved and issued in accordance with project and company procedures.

- Provide regular progress reporting covering Health & Safety, programme, technical, commercial and design matters for both internal and external stakeholders.
- Resolve technical, commercial and operational issues in collaboration with Contracts Management, Regional Management and Technical Services.
- Manage project resources effectively, including coordination of project team diaries to meet programme and client expectations.
- Ensure all projects are fully handed over to the maintenance department with complete and compliant documentation.
- Identify training needs within the delivery team and support the supervision, mentoring and development of less experienced project engineers.
- Support the Sales and Marketing teams in maintaining and developing relationships with existing and future clients.
